DR. GILBERT CORELLA, PRINCIPAL CONDUCTOR

Retiring from The United States Air Force Band after 25 years of service, Dr. Corella continues to perform as a soloist and clinician at colleges and universities throughout the United States. He is currently the tuba/euphonium professor at George Washington University, and is the founder and Executive Director for the Serapis Foundation, whose mission is to promote music education and appreciation. He earned his Doctorate of Musical Arts degree in May of 2005, as the school's first-ever graduate in tuba performance. Retired Colonel Arnald D. Gabriel and Professor Anthony Maiello are amongst his most influential teachers, as well as Baltimore Symphony principal tubist David Fedderly and the former National Symphony principal trombonist Milt Stevens.

JANICE REKSTEN CARL, NARRATOR

Mezzo-soprano Janice Reksten Carl is a frequent soloist and alto vocalist with the premier chorus of the United States Air Force, The Singing Sergeants. In this capacity, she has performed across the country in 48 states in a wide variety of styles, from classical, jazz, pop and country. While in Washington, DC, she has performed for three U.S. Presidents, Vice Presidents, the Joint Chiefs of Staff, as well as members of Congress and foreign dignitaries. She also participated in the historic State Funerals of Presidents Ronald Reagan and Gerald Ford. Career highlights include performances for the David Letterman Show, the Fiesta Bowl, and at the dedication of the Pentagon's 9/11 Monument. She has worked with such talents as Patti LaBelle, Peter Cetera, Chaka Khan, Frederica Von Stade, Steve Martin and Brad Paisley, among others. A great lover of Renaissance polyphony, she is a proud member of the 8-person professional resident scholar at St. Catherine of Siena Church in Great Falls, Va. She received her Bachelor of Music in Vocal Performance degree from Oral Roberts University, with additional studies at The University of Paris - La Sorbonne. Janice and her husband Edward currently reside in Ashburn, Va.
