ED JONES, GUEST CONDUCTOR

Ed Jones has lived in Woodbridge since 1970, and taught for many years in the Prince William County Schools. His bands have always been exceptional, as reflected in the consistently high ratings they earned. He has adjudicated across the entire Mid-Atlantic region.

Mr. Jones, honored with East Carolina University's Distinguished Alumni Award, has twice received the Seefeldt Award for Excellence in the Arts. After retiring as Prince William County's School Music Supervisor in 1998, he founded a ground-breaking band program for home-schooled students, which he teaches to this day. The organizer of the Prince William Community Band, he served as its music director for the first 20 years of its existence.
