### BILL SNIFFIN, CONDUCTOR

Bill Sniffin is a native of South Florida, born there in 1961. He picked up his first instrument, trumpet, at age 6, and started bassoon at age 12. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Music Performance from Furman University in Greenville, SC, a Master's degree in Music Performance from the State University of New York Stony Brook, and a Masters in Orchestral Conducting from the University of Texas at Austin.

Bill moved to the Washington DC area (after much unobtrusive prodding from Gil Corella) in 1990. He has been a member of the Prince George's Philharmonic since that time, as well as serves on their Board of Directors since 1997. He has been performing with the LSW for the past several seasons.

### CHARLES TAYLOR, CONDUCTOR

Charles Taylor was born in 1959 in Cherry Hill, NJ. He majored in Composition at the Eastman School of Music in Rochester, NY, studying composition with Samuel Adler, Warren Benson, and Joseph Schwantner, and bassoon with K. David Van Hoesen. In Rochester he performed locally and nationally with Nik and the Nice Guys.
