DR. GILBERT CORELLA

music director



Dr. Corella began his musical career with the United States Air Force Band in 1985. He participated in ceremonies ranging from State arrivals at the White House to full honors funerals at Arlington National Cemetery and represented the Air Force as a soloist and clinician at conferences worldwide.

He later moved into administration to become the director of the Air Force Band's Chamber Series program and eventually joined the public affairs team. He built partnerships with civilian and other military organizations to promote the Air Force's public image. He managed radio and television productions as well as represented the Air Force at international music education conferences. After serving 25 years, he retired as the Director of Special Events.

Dr. Corella is featured on several compact discs, including *The Bear (Unnatural Ax)*; *Side by Side*, *A Klezmer Service*, *National Taptoe*, and *Tower Music*. In 2003, he founded the Serapis Foundation, whose mission is to educate and stimulate awareness on the diversity of musical expression with a focus on diverse and economically challenged children.

His degrees include a Bachelor of Arts from the Catholic University of America; a Masters of Arts in conducting and performance from George Mason University; and a Doctorate of Musical Arts from the Catholic University of America - as the first-ever graduate in tuba performance.

about the artist

GUNHILD CARLING

is a world-famous Swedish jazz musician, singer-songwriter, and vaudeville artist with over 70 million views on YouTube, Facebook, and more. A multi-instrumentalist, she plays trumpet, trombone, bagpipes, piano, harp, harmonica, recorder, and ukulele (and more), and captivates audiences with her tap dancing. Carling toured Europe starting at a very early age with her family, showcasing her extraordinary versatility. Beyond leading her own band, Carling has performed with Postmodern Jukebox, Carling Family, Count Basie Orchestra, WDR Big Band, Papa Bue's Viking Jazzband, Christer Sjögren, Macey Gray, Sabrina Carpenter, the California Symphony, Musica Vitae, the Meridia Symphony Orchestra, and many others. Gunhild's unforgettable talent has also been featured on television shows such as ABC News, Dancing with the Stars (Sweden), and America's Got Talent.

Gunhild Carling was born in 1975 in Gothenburg, Sweden, into a family of accomplished musicians and performers. Her father, Hans Carling (1945-2017) played trumpet and piano; her mother, Aina Carling, plays banjo, violin, and guitar. Brother Max plays clarinet, violin, saxophone, and piano and is also a rope dancer, juggler, composer, and band leader. Gunhild's sister Gerd Carling plays piano, trombone, saxophone and vibraphone; she is also a band leader and scientist. Ulf, another brother, plays drums and trumpet, and sings and dances.

In 2000 Gunhild received her degree in Orchestral Harp along with a Bachelors degree in linguistics from Lund University. From 2006 to 2016, Gunhild Carling organized the festival "Stockamöllan SWING & JAZZ" in her hometown of Stockamöllan, featuring artists from all over the world. From 2008 to 2016, she also arranged a large annual jazz tour in Sweden with her own big band, string section, and dancers, running each year in January and February. In its final year, the tour covered 25 cities in just one month.

Gunhild lived in southern Sweden with her husband, Johan, and their children, Idun and Viggo, until 2018, when they relocated to Cupertino, California.

From 2018-2022, she toured all over the US with American band Postmodern Jukebox. In 2016, she played for the King of Sweden Carl XVI Gustaf's 70th birthday.

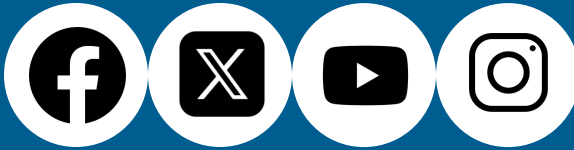
